- Schedule facilitated meeting(s) to develop vision statement and goals
 - Representatives of all parties should be invited. Use results of survey as basis for activities
 - Outcome :
 - Proposed Vision Statement for the neighborhood (meeting 1)
 - Communicated in agreed upon format
 - Actionable goals, ideally prioritized (meeting 2) - limit to 1-3 for the year
 - Communicated in agreed upon format
- Final approval of the BOD and/or vote of SANA members
 - Communicated in agreed upon format
- Identify a Board Champion for each goal
Their job is to solicit volunteers to help, maintain visibility, keep the project moving, and regularly report on status
